The League of Women Voters of California writes to request your signature on AB 102 (Holden), which addresses recommendations in the April 2021 report required by AB 288 and affirms and further institutionalizes California's commitment to providing opportunities for high school students to take community college coursework.

The League prioritizes and supports equitable access to public higher education and equitable rates of completion. In particular, we support programs that foster coordination and articulation between preK-12 school districts and public higher education so that all high school graduates are prepared for college-level coursework and/or gainful employment. Furthermore, we believe that it is
