The California State Association of Counties (CSAC) is pleased to support Senate Bill 418 (Laird), which will extend the sunset provision for the Planning for Sea Level Rise Database until January 1, 2028. California is a national leader in addressing sea level rise and SB 418 will ensure stakeholders at the forefront of addressing climate change and protecting our coastal communities continue to have access to this invaluable educational and assessment tool. This information includes various studies, programs, modeling, mapping, cost-benefit analyses, vulnerability assessments, adaptation assessments, and local coastal programs that have been created to prepare for sea level rise.
