## RE: Senate Bill 636 (Cortese) – Removal of Opposition As Amended June 21, 2023

Dear Assembly Member Holden:

On behalf of the Rural County Representatives of California (RCRC), we are removing our opposition to SB 636 (Cortese), which would require psychologist or physician who conducts workers' compensation utilization review (UR) for private employers to be licensed in California.

While the bill exempts public agencies from licensing requirement for physicians, provisions requiring UR physicians to have the same duty of care to the employee as a treating physician would impact public employers.

The June 21 amendments addressed our concerns by removing the duty of care provisions. The amendments allow our organization to remove our opposition.
