RE: Senate Bill 571 (Allen) Fire safety regulations: development projects: ingress and egress route standards.

Dear Assembly Member Bryan:

On behalf of the Rural County Representatives of California (RCRC), we are pleased to support Senate Bill 571, authored by Senator Ben Allen. RCRC is an association of forty rural California counties and the RCRC Board of Directors is comprised of elected supervisors from each of those member counties.

SB 571 requires the Office of Planning and Research to conduct a study evaluating potential improvements to state standards related to evacuation routes for all new developments in the event of a natural disaster. RCRC member counties include some of the lands most prone to natural disasters, especially wildfires. While creating standards for ingress and egress in these areas to ensure safety for residents during a natural disaster is paramount, it must be based on data and reasonably balanced with feasibility and other state priorities, such as increased residential construction. SB 571 represents a balanced approach to evaluating safety standards for disaster readiness and was written in collaboration with stakeholders, including RCRC.
